



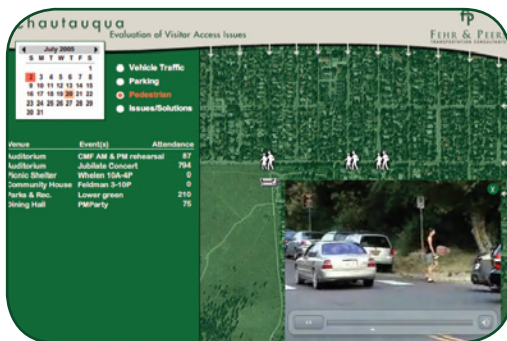
Web Applications & Online Project Presentations

Interactive web-based presentation of project information and solutions

Allow project stakeholders or the public at-large to:

- view vast amounts of project information
- interactively query data on current traffic, parking, transit, bike and pedestrian conditions
- see the effects future effects of growth, development or any other anticipated changes in transportation conditions
- review proposed solutions to any existing or projected problems

The web-based interactive library allows users to view information by calendar date, by mode or type of transportation, and by different scenarios for future changes. Two types of service are available:



Innovis

Dynamic web-sites or portable media that function as interactive project reports, allowing visitors to browse information on traffic, parking and bike/pedestrian conditions and to examine the effects of potential transportation solutions.



MainStreet

Traditional project websites that provide project team members and the general public project status reports, schedules, interactive chat and opinion polling and other open communication capabilities. Design of the site also helps establish project identity and branding. Site also serves as a central clearinghouse for your project's administrative information and documentation.

Project Planners and Sponsors

To facilitate an interactive process for description and review of a project's multi-modal transportation effects and solutions to any projected problems.

Local and Regional Jurisdictions

To provide an open forum for decision makers and community members to understand a land use or transportation proposal and its impacts and mitigations.

- **How is it better than what I already have?**

When project information is voluminous or complex, conventional reporting makes disclosure to broad audiences difficult. Interactive web-based information sources provide ready access to information, clear understanding of project characteristics and effects provide an opportunity for fully informed public discourse.
